This month I'll bring you up-to-date on some of the new things that we have happening and a brief update on some of the old projects & things that are continuing on.

New Court Lines:

You should have received an email from me informing you that in August 2020, Courtside will be getting new court lines on courts; 4, 5, 6, 7, 8 & 9. In June 2019 the lines were already replaced on courts 1, 2 & 3.

Kitchen Remodel:

Most of you know that currently our kitchen area is being remodeled. Soon we will have a more up to date looking, and more user-friendly kitchen. This project is being headed by Karen Scott, so thank you Karen for taking the lead.

Hand Soap:
